


Laser Etched Inscription (Black Granite Only)

Laser etched inscriptions provide modern, cost effective and highly detailed options.

Our laser removes 0.2mm of the polished finish and leaves the inscription exposed in the natural rock. After this process is completed, the exposed etching is painted in with a whitening enamel to provide a prominent contrast

With micro-millimetre accuracy, laser etching provides sharp, photo realistic details for images, logos and motifs.



Piddingtons have been producing our own laser & sandblasted monuments since 2017.

A mix of sandblasting and laser etching can be combined on a single monument to create a fusion of traditional charm with modern precision.

All services can be performed on our range of granite headstones, panels and slopers.



Monument Restorations

Piddingtons provide a complete renovation and restoration service for tired, worn or broken memorials and graves.

Our team will survey a memorial and provide a written report detailing the best method to restore it's former glory. We offer cleaning, revival of old inscriptions, add-on inscriptions, levelling and can supply a selection of granite chippings and polished pebbles for graves.

The Design Process

At Piddingtons, the process of creating a personalised memorial or monument for your loved one is a uncomplicated one.

Our team works meticulously with you to produce timeless monuments that suit your inscription ideas, imagery, wording and size requirements.

Initial consultation with our monumental team to discuss your ideas, costs, sizes, logistics and inscription details.

Our design team commence drafting your requests. The design team will send you samples. Once you have approved the design, we progress to the next step.

3

Our on-site monumental masons can commence the laser etching/sandblasting, after which, the construction and installation phase can begin to complete the job.

Headstone Terminology

Side Profiles

Looking from the side of a monument, you'll notice how many can be different thicknesses, slopes and finished around the edges.



Desk Headstone

This refers to the headstone being wider at the base than the top.



Slopers

Like a desk headstone, this lies flat with a slope towards the viewer. This selection is perfect for beam monuments.



Rock edge

Showcasing the natural look of the granite. You can choose to have sides only or optionally, back and sides with rock edge finish.



Plate Headstone

This refers to the headstone being the one thickness from top to base.




Panels

Panels are a uniform depth and come in 3 different thicknesses, 10, 20 & 30mm. Panels are then mounted to bases, slopers or headstones.




Polished edge

This refers to the entire monument being polished. All sides have been polished to mirror finish.







Rounded Corner Serp Top





Headstone

A headstone is the final piece to a monument. Choose your size, style, inscription, granite type, laser or sand-blasted inscriptions, motifs and imagery.

Base

The base is what the headstone sits upon. Choose granite colour/style and thickness. Additionally, you can opt to add vase(s), Piddingtons have a selection of vases available. For a beam monument, a base is required to mount a headstone, panel or sloper.

Ledger

Spanning a full monument lies the ledger. You can add vases, choose granite colour/style or can be optionally removed to leave space for granite chippings or even garden soil to add plantings.


Kerbs

Underneath the ledger lies the kerbs. Selections available: granite colour/style and thickness. Available thicknesses are 150mm, 200mm & 300mm.

Foundation/Beam

Monuments start with the foundation. Depending on the site, this is the main boundary of all monuments. At Piddingtons we use high tensile & reinforced concrete to maintain strength, then render to give the monument a beautiful finished look.

Laser Etching & Sandblasting



There are a range of inscription methods and styles available including:

Incised:

This inscription is made by etching away only the inscription.

This is available for:

Sandblasting/Laser Etching

Raised Polished:

Displays the text or motifs as polished with the background being etched away, exposing the natural stone below.

Laser Etch Imagery:

Almost any image, logo or picture can be etched into granite with pinpoint accuracy.

This is available for:

Laser Etching - Black Granite Only

Natural:

As the name suggests, the etched inscription is left natural, exposing the natural stone.

This is available for:

Sandblasting/Laser Etching

Painted:

Once sandblasted, a coloured epoxy enamel is added to make the inscription have a greater contrast. You can even fill in sandblasted motifs with colour.

Gold Gilding:

By adding 24ct gold leaf to the sandblasted inscriptions gives the headstone a beautiful and timeless look.




